Supervisors must ensure that risks from assigned work are mitigated to an ALARP level and documented properly. They must demonstrate leadership by constant and consistent supervision and active monitoring of crews. GDI Management provides suitable and sufficient resources to manage the worksite according to these objectives.

To implement these objectives and our QHSE goals, we are committed and shall ensure;

- Fulfill applicable legal and other requirements, eliminate hazards and reduce OH&S risks
- Preserve and protect the environment, ensure no damages to its assets and property and preserve its reputation as a world class drilling services provider. Manage risks effectively as per the framework of IMS and Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) and industry best practices
- Ensure consultation and participation of workers through their representatives and personnel are trained and competent for the tasks assigned to them
- Tools and equipment are of adequate design, condition & quality, to be operated safely
- Policies and procedures are reviewed with employee consultation and updated in a risk-based approach, not exceeding a maximum timeframe of three years
- Hazards are identified, and risks are assessed and mitigated to 'as low as reasonably practicable' (ALARP) level and the worksites are maintained in safe condition.
- Undesirable events are reported and investigated as per company policy and important QHSE information is regularly communicated as Safety Alert/Flash.
- Review of annual 'Key Performance Indicators' by Management

All personnel are empowered and required to use STOP Work Authority and report behavioral based observations through GDI Essentials Reporting.
